

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE: MARCH 7, 2017

Amy Frederick, the Ford County Clerk and Recorder is reminding everyone that the last day to register to vote for the April 4, 2017 Consolidated Election is March 7, 2017.

The registration requirements to be eligible to register to vote are:

- **Must be a citizen of the United States;**
- **Must be 18 years of age by Election Day;**
- **Must have been a resident of the Precinct at least 30 days prior to Election Day.**

When registering to vote, two forms of identification are required – one must show the current name and address of the applicant.

Those missing the March 7, 2017 deadline may register during Grace Period Registration that runs March 8, 2017 thru Election Day April 4, 2017 (ONLY in the County Clerk's Office).

During the Grace Period, those who register at the Ford County Clerk's Office and must be prepared to vote at that time. Early Voting will begin on Thursday, February 23, 2017 (if available) and will end Election Day, Tuesday, April 4, 2017.

Please check your Voter's Card to make sure it is up to date to avoid a line at the Polls on Election Day. Any questions please feel free to contact the Ford County Clerk's Office at 217-379-9400.
