

**FORD COUNTY BOARD SPECIFICALLY
BUDGET COMMITTEE MEETING
OCTOBER 2, 2017**

The Budget Committee met on Monday, October 2, 2017 at 6:21 P.M. in the Sheriff's Boardroom in the Ford County Jail. Those in attendance were: Chairman McCall, Mr. Nuss, Mr. May, Mr. Berger, Sheriff Doran, Coroner Wallace, Treasurer Stevens, Circuit Clerk Evans, Assessor Langland, State's Attorney Killian, Ford Co. Engineer, Greg Perkinson, Public Health Director, Lana Sample and Clerk Frederick. Mr. Lindgren, Dave Hastings, and Mr. Ferguson were not present.

Mr. Berger moved to approve the Agenda. Mr. Nuss seconded it. Voice Vote - Carried

Chairman McCall started the meeting by stating department heads have made cuts to their budgets as much as possible and it is much appreciated. Lana Sample, Public Health Dept. Director discussed the possibility of taking over the day to day EMA work. The lack of Ford County not being compliant with the State of Illinois is now affecting the Public Health Dept.'s grant income. The issue will be discussed with the Board of Health at the next meeting in October.
