

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE: OCTOBER 9, 2018

Amy Frederick, the Ford County Clerk and Recorder is reminding everyone that the last day to register to vote for the November 6, 2018 General Election is October 9, 2018.

The registration requirements to be eligible to register to vote are:

- **Must be a citizen of the United States;**
- **Must be 18 years of age by Election Day;**  
**(17 years of age to vote in a General Primary if individual will be 18 as of the following General Election);**
- **Must have been a resident of the Precinct at least 30 days prior to Election Day.**

When registering to vote, two forms of identification are required – one must show the current name and address of the applicant.

Those missing the October 9, 2018 deadline may register during Grace Period Registration that runs October 10, 2018 thru Election Day November 6, 2018 (ONLY in the County Clerk's Office).

During the Grace Period, those who register at the Ford County Clerk's Office must be prepared to vote at that time. Early Voting will begin on Thursday, September 27, 2018 (if available) and will end Monday, November 5, 2018.

Please check your Voter's Card to make sure it is up to date to avoid a line at the Polls on Election Day. Any questions please feel free to contact the Ford County Clerk's Office at 217-379-9400.
