

**FORD COUNTY BOARD SPECIFICALLY  
SHERIFF & PROPERTY COMMITTEE MEETING  
DECEMBER 5, 2018**

The Sheriff and Property Committee met in the Sheriff's Boardroom at the Jail on Wednesday, December 5, 2018, at 9:00 A.M. Those in attendance were: Chairman Johnson, Mr. Lindgren, Mr. McQuinn, Dr. Ray, Mrs. Smith, Mrs. C. Ihrke, Sheriff Doran, Coroner Flessner and Clerk Frederick.

Mrs. Smith moved to approve the Agenda. Mr. McQuinn seconded it. Voice Vote - Carried

The Sheriff, Housing, and EMA bills were then reviewed. Mr. Lindgren moved to recommend to the board that all bills be approved. Dr. Ray seconded it. Voice Vote - Carried

The Corner stated it has been a busy year and briefly went through his monthly and annual reports.

Mr. McQuinn discussed briefly that an Insurance and Personnel meeting was held to go through applications for the EMA position. He would recommend that the board hire Mr. Whitebird for the EMA position.

Sheriff Doran went through his monthly and annual reports. Sheriff Doran then stated he has 3 renewal contracts with the Villages of Roberts, Melvin and Kempton and 3 renewal Dispatch Agreements with Gibson Area Hospital, Gibson City Police and Paxton Police. Mr. McQuinn made a motion to pass all 6 renewals and agreements to the County Board. Mr. Lindgren seconded it. Voice Vote - Carried

Sheriff then discussed a graph showing the savings of ESPY Services. He then discussed 2 options for a new vehicle purchase. He discussed hiring a new road deputy which he already has permission for. Sheriff stated he will only be replacing one of the refrigerator/freezers for now and maybe the other next year. He replaced the dishwasher however the heat exchange on the wall went out. There is a new medical drop off box in the Sheriff's lobby for those to properly dispose of non-liquid medicines no longer needed. Also no needles or inhalers are allowed to be disposed of in this container.

Mr. McQuinn moved to adjourn. Mr. Lindgren seconded it.
