





JUNE 2020 SUPERVISOR OF ASSESSMENTS REPORT

This office rolled the 2019 assessments to the clerk's office on Friday, May 29, 2020 with a tentative multiplier of 1.0240. I have attached the 3-year sales ratio study to help explain it. Although I wish it was different, I'm not all together surprised given 2016 & 2017 all other (rural townships) values that we are trying to correct. After a conversation with the State and Fred Magers (the assessor of most townships) I feel confident that we are on the right track.

Amy, Krisha, Andrew and I spoke about the 2020 assessments and made a plan. Again, after talking with Fred, we hope to have all work turned in to our office and valued by mid/late June. Following that I will send the tentative abstract in to the State and hope to have the Board of Review hearings in August. I have contacted those members and asked them to check their calendars for available dates. The biggest issue with work getting turned into the State on time is getting the permits on time. The 2019 permits were not received until April 2020 leaving us approximately a month before we would like to have it all viewed and valued. That is not a feasible schedule. We need the






COMPLETED permit applications and permits within 30 days of issuance. This will allow the township assessors the time needed to view and our office the time needed to value.

Per the State we will be rolling all exemptions from last year. What that means is that any tax payer who qualified for an exemption in 2019 will automatically receive that same exemption in 2020 regardless of paperwork being turned in due to COVID 19.

If this will be the first year a taxpayer would receive the exemption, they need to contact us, so we can get their information.

Now that we have rolled 2019 to Amy's office, we have started the 2020 assessment work, including the Paxton quad and updating the cards with new farmland values.
