

FORD COUNTY BOARD MINUTES

April 14, 2014

A. CALL TO ORDER:

The County Board of Ford County met pursuant to adjournment in the Ford County Board Room of the Ford County Jail in Paxton on Monday, April 14, 2014, at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by County Board Chairman, Rick Bowen.

E. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

I. REPORT OF PROBATION OFFICER:

Cassy Taylor presented her report. There were 13 new adult cases filed. There are 5 adults in residential alcohol/drug treatment. There were 9 PTR'S filed and 2 PSI'S ordered. There are 4 adults placed in residential or group home. The Probation officers presented information at community meetings and held a GCMS rap at the Junior High. Cassy emailed all the board members the information of the potential changes to the budget situation for probation.

J. REPORT OF CIRCUIT CLERK:

Mrs. Evans reported that she had jury today. She said that there will be a jury trial next Monday.

K. REPORT OF THE TREASURER:

Treasurer Hastings presented her report. The county has a balance of \$307,737.90 as of March 31, 2014. The auditor will probably be presenting the audit report at the May Finance Committee Meeting.

Mr. Berger moved to approve the Probation, Circuit Clerk and Treasurers monthly reports and to place them on file. Mr. Hastings seconded it.

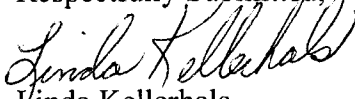
