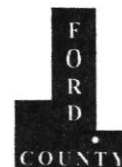

Present at this regular scheduled meeting were committee members Bob Lindgren, Jon Clark, David Hastings Tim Nuss and Bud Otto. County Board Chairman Randy Berger and County Engineer Greg Perkinson were also present. Mr. Otto called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m.

First on the agenda was the review of the March minutes. Mr. Nuss moved and Mr. Lindgren seconded the motion that they be approved as presented. The motion carried.

March bills were read and presented by Mr. Perkinson. Mr. Berger moved and Mr. Hastings seconded the motion to approve the bills and present to the full board. The motion carried.
