

The Ford County Highway Committee met on July 7, 2020, at the Ford County Highway Department in Roberts, Illinois.

Present at this regular scheduled meeting was committee chairman Tim Nuss, Chuck Aubry, Jason Johnson and Ann Irhke. County Engineer Greg Perkinson, County Board Chairman Robert Lindgren and EMA Director Terry Whitebird were also present. Mr. Nuss called the meeting to order at 7:00 a.m.

Mrs. Irhke moved to accept the Agenda. Seconded by Mr. Aubry. Motion passed.

There was no June meeting.

Mr. Whitebird discussed the continuing distribution of PPE supplies. He is currently working on paperwork for cost reimbursement. Also working on locations for sheltering in Ford County.

June bills were read and presented by Mr. Perkinson. Mr. Aubry moved and Mrs. Irhke seconded the motion to approve the bills and present to the full board. The motion carried.

The committee then reviewed the fund balance report and the highway appropriations and expenses report.

Under old business the following items were discussed:

Mr. Perkinson informed the committee of the activities at the County Highway Department during the month of June and will provide a written report for the full board.

Mr. Perkinson met with Mr. Lenz, APEX and the Township Road Commissioners to develop the windfarm Road Use Agreement.

New Business:

A constituent questioned the need for Township government. The Committee supports Township Government as an efficient and cost-effective way to serve taxpayers.

Bids will be opened at the August meeting for replacing a large culvert in Pella Township.




FORD COUNTY INMATES TOTAL MANDAYS TO DATE (2826) This Month's Ford County Inmate Mandays:161



JULY 2020 SUPERVISOR OF ASSESSMENTS REPORT

This office is waiting to get 2017, 2018, 2019 sales ratio study from IDOR to finish the 2020 tax roll. At that time, we will decide if any township factors are needed and work with CIC on the 2020 tentative abstract. I would like to let the Board know that even with 3 family deaths due to COVID, Fred Magers worked diligently with us to get properties viewed so that we could value parcels that we have received permits for 2020.

I want to again address the permits. Fred as well as any other assessors need <u>COMPLETED</u> permit applications and permits within 30 days of issuance. The information required for a **complete application** should include, at least, the PIN, address & phone number of the applicant, what is being constructed, the size/sqft of improvement as well as the estimated cost of the project. The practice of the City of Paxton has been to ask for that information, but it is not always supplied. The practice of the County has been to only ask for a PIN and improvement type and size, at least as far as Fred, Phyllis and I can tell from what is provided to us. Receiving this information in a timely




manner will allow the township assessors the time needed to view and our office the time needed to value.

Again, per the State we will be rolling all exemptions from last year. What that means is that any tax payer who qualified for an exemption in 2019 will automatically receive that same exemption in 2020 regardless of paperwork being turned in due to COVID 19.

If this will be the first year a taxpayer would receive the exemption, they need to contact us, so we can get their information.

Attached is a bill from MCS that I feel should be a part of our monthly maintenance. This was an update required when both mine and Katie's computers stopped having the ability to print. Also attached is an email I sent to Tim Nuss in support of switching to Viscon from MCS. Viscon was so professional and helpful when they didn't have to be. I appreciate that they took the time to help me.

As a side note, I cancelled my vacation planned for July 3-13 due to COVID cases spiking in North Carolina.
