Ford County Highway Committee Minutes

The Ford County Highway Committee met on November 4, 2020, at the Ford County Highway Department in Roberts, Illinois.

Present at this regular scheduled meeting was committee chairman Tim Nuss, Chuck Aubry and Ann Irhke. County Engineer Greg Perkinson, County Board Chairman Robert Lindgren and EMA Director Terry Whitebird were also present. Mr. Nuss called the meeting to order at 7:00 a.m.

Mr. Nuss moved to accept the Agenda. Seconded by Mrs. Irhke. Motion passed.

First on the agenda was the review of the October minutes. Mr. Aubry moved and Mrs. Irhke seconded the motion that they be approved. The motion carried.

Mr. Whitebird discussed the continuing distribution of PPE supplies. Partial Emergency Operations Center in place.

October bills were read and presented by Mr. Perkinson. Mr. Aubry moved and Mrs. Irhke seconded the motion to approve the bills and present to the full board. The motion carried.

The committee then reviewed the fund balance report and the highway appropriations and expenses report.

Under old business the following items were discussed:

Mr. Perkinson informed the committee of the activities at the County Highway Department during the month of October and will provide a written report for the full board.

Mr. Perkinson updated the committee on the Road Use Agreement for the Ford County Wind Farm. Apex has proposed some amendments to the RUA which are still under discussion with the Township Road Commissioners.

The bridge on the Loda road just west of Route 115 is complete and the road reopened on October 29th.

Mr. Perkinson presented a spread sheet with graphs showing the recent history of the Motor Fuel Tax Allotments for the original 19 cents, the new Renewal Fund 19 cents, and the Rebuild Illinois Bond Fund.

The consultant report on the road ditch drainage along 1600 E road adjacent to Mr. Birch's property has been received and will be discussed with Mr. Birch this month.

Mr. Perkinson presented a Resolution to Update Engineering Rates. It was moved by Mr. Nuss and seconded by Mr. Aubry to present the resolution to the full board for approval. Motion passed.


