


#### MARCH 2021 SUPERVISOR OF ASSESSMENTS REPORT

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1602 would relinquish local authority, and the determination of needs specific to an area, to others who do not reside in the community; and

**NOW BE IT DECLARED** that the Ford County Board opposes Senate Bill 1602, any trailer bill or any bill similar thereto and stands with our residents' right to make decisions in land-use planning for the legacy of their communities, areas, and future generations and respectfully request our right to make decisions in zoning and land-use planning remain with the County Board and local zoning procedure.
