

Notice of Proposed Property Tax Increase for Ford County

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Ford County for year 2021 (FY 2022) will be held on Monday, December 13, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. at the Sheriff's Board Room, 235 N. American St., Paxton, Illinois 60957.

- II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for year 2020 (FY 2021) were \$3,273,663.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes levied for year 2021 (FY 2022) are \$3,756,911. This represents a 14.7620% increase over the previous year.

- III. The property taxes extended for debt services and public building commission leases for year 2020 (FY 2021) were \$496,112.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt services and public Building commission leases for year 2021 (FY 2022) are \$466,768. This represents a 5.915% decrease over the previous year.

- IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for year 2020 (FY 2021) were \$3,769,775.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2021 (FY 2022) are \$4,223,679. This is a 12.0408% increase over the previous year.
