



The Ford County Highway Committee met on July 5, 2022 at the Ford County Highway Department in Roberts, Illinois.

Present at this regular scheduled meeting were Jason Johnson, Ann Ihrke, Chase McCall, and Lesley King. County Engineer Greg Perkinson, and EMA Director Terry Whitebird were also present. Mrs. Ihrke called the meeting to order at 7:00 a.m.

Mr. McCall moved to accept the Agenda. Seconded by Mrs. King. Motion passed.

First on the agenda was the review of the June 7, 2022 minutes. Mr. McCall moved and Mr. Johnson seconded the motion that they be approved. Motion passed.

Mr. Whitebird discussed the activities of the Emergency Management Office during last month.

June bills were read and presented by Mr. Perkinson. Mrs. King moved and Mr. McCall seconded the motion to approve the bills and present to the full board. Motion passed.
