Any person may register to vote now through Tuesday, February 17, 2026.

If you are unable to get to a place of registration, you may contact this office at 217-379-9400 regarding alternative sites for registration.

If unable to vote in person, a registered voter may request an application for a ballot by printing an application from our website: [fordcounty.illinois.gov](http://fordcounty.illinois.gov), under Elections, click on Vote by Mail Application or by calling, writing or emailing the Ford County Clerk & Recorder's Office.

People with disabilities and the elderly wishing to vote **Early**, may do so in the Ford County Clerk & Recorder's Office starting Thursday, February 5, 2026 (if available) through Monday, March 16, 2026. The Illinois Election Law [10 ILCS 5/19A-25] allows for Early Voting.

The office of the Ford County Clerk & Recorder will be open Monday through Friday from 8:30 A.M. until 4:30 P.M. (except for any holidays set by Resolution by the Ford County Board). In addition to regular office hours, the Ford County Clerk & Recorder's Office will be open for **Voting** from 8:30 A.M. to 12:00 Noon on Saturday, March 14, 2026.
