

**FORD COUNTY BOARD SPECIFICALLY
EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MINUTES**

The Executive Committee met on Tuesday, June 2nd, 2026 in the Sheriff's Boardroom of the Ford County jail. Chairman McCall called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

Chairman McCall administered roll call which showed the following committee members present: Randy Ferguson, Greg Niewold, Carson Vaughn, and Chairman Chase McCall. Quorum was established.
