ASSISTANCE IN VOTING

Voting aids and assistance in marking a ballot are available to elderly voters and voters with disabilities as provided by law. Accessible voting equipment is available for voters who require assistance in casting their ballot.

A registered voter may request an application for a Vote by Mail ballot by contacting the Ford County Clerk & Recorder's Office by phone, mail, or email, or by obtaining an application through the Ford County website.

EARLY VOTING

Early Voting for the November 3, 2026, General Election begins **Thursday, September 24, 2026**, and continues through **Monday, November 2, 2026**.
